



## Clean Cities Congress and Expo Pavilions

### **Concept:**

The alternative fuel and advanced vehicle technology industries are increasingly working together to grow market share. Many associations and organizations focus on just one fuel or technology. ### **How It Works:**

1. Select the Pavilion in which you would like to have your exhibit.
2. Determine the number of booths you would like.
3. Sign up and pay by December 15, 2005. You will receive the online registration rate, but please coordinate directly with Claudia Goetz at 702-254-4180, ext. 24 or [claudia@afvi.org](mailto:claudia@afvi.org)
4. You will be notified if enough companies have not signed on to create a Pavilion for your chosen area.

### **Pavilion Rules**

1. Each Pavilion will consist of at least ten booths, with at least five different businesses represented.
2. The booth space purchased by Pavilion participants must be occupied by the company that purchased it.
3. As of December 15th, 2005, no additional exhibitors will be added to the Pavilion.
4. All other rules spelled out in the Exhibitor Prospectus apply to Pavilion exhibitors.

5. To be eligible for the Premier Sponsor booth rate, a company or organization must have agreed to and paid for a sponsorship with a minimum cash contribution of \$15,000.
